Minutes of Wednesday, May 25, 2016: Mrs. Delaplane moved to approve the minutes as read; motion seconded by Mr. Rhoades and all voted YEA.

IN THE MATTER OF LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION FOR VILLAGE OF ARCANUM-CDBG PROJECT FROM PROJECT ENGINEER MOTE & ASSOCIATES

Mr. Rhoades moved to approve the following "Letter of Recommendation"; motion seconded by Mrs. Delaplane and all voted YEA.

This letter is being written in response to construction bids received on May 23, 2016 for the completion of the project referenced above which includes CDBG funding. There were two bids received and an itemized breakdown of the bids is attached hereto. Each contractor provided a Base Bid and Alternate Bid for the following work:

Base Bid – 10” deep cement stabilized subgrade (with 6% cement), 1 ½” asphalt concrete intermediate course, 1 ½” asphalt concrete surface course, reclamite, seeding & mulching, 200 SF of sidewalk replacement and miscellaneous incidentals.

Alternate Bid #1 – Utilize 5% cement with subgrade stabilization instead of the 6% cement as included in the base bid.

The low bid was submitted by Ray Hensley, Inc. from Springfield, Ohio. We have reviewed their bid package and all documentation has been completed and submitted in accordance with the contract documents. We have also contacted several references that were included in the Bidders Qualifications and found Ray Hensley, Inc. completed these projects satisfactorily and in a timely manner. The Village of Arcanum also contracted with Ray Hensley, Inc. in 2009 for the completion of the George Street Reconstruction project.

The Arcanum Council passed a motion recommending that the project be awarded to Ray Hensley, Inc., in an amount of \$103,965.00 per the base bid. Therefore, Mote and Associates, Inc. recommends to the Darke County Commissioners the award of the Arcanum Pavement Resurfacing with Subgrade Stabilization contract to Ray Hensley, Inc. based on the review of the submitted bid and the action taken by the Arcanum Council.

IN THE MATTER OF OHIO ENTERPRISE ZONE AGREEMENT BETWEEN GREENVILLE TWP., DARKE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND E B FUEL STOPS, LLC

Mrs. Delaplane moved to approve the signing of the following Agreement; motion was seconded by Mr. Rhoades and all voted YEA.

This agreement made and entered into between Greenville Township, an Ohio township, with its main offices located at 5366 St. Rt. 571 E., Greenville, OH 45331 (hereinafter referred to as "TOWNSHIP"), THE Darke County Board of Commissioners, Ohio, a County with its main offices located at 520 S. Broadway, Greenville, Ohio 45331 (hereinafter referred to as COUNTY"), AND E B FUEL STOPS, LLC, an Ohio Limited Liability Company with its main offices located at 10501 State Route 118, Ansonia, OH 45308(hereinafter referred to as "Company").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, TOWNSHIP and COUNTY have encouraged the development of real property and the acquisition of personal property located in the area designated as an Enterprise Zone; and

WHEREAS, COMPANY is desirous of establishing a new fuel station and truck stop facility, (hereinafter referred to as the 'PROJECT") within the boundaries of the aforementioned Enterprise Zone, provided that the appropriate development incentives are available to support the economic viability of said PROJECT; and

WHEREAS, Greenville Township, Ohio by Resolution No. 99-10 adopted September 13, 1999, designated the area as an "Enterprise Zone" pursuant to Chapter 5709 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Darke County Commissioners, Ohio, by Resolution No. R-102-99 adopted September 15, 1999, designated the area as an "Enterprise Zone" pursuant to Chapter 5709 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, effective September 24, 1999, the Director of Development of the State of Ohio determined that the aforementioned area designated in said Resolution No. 99-10 and R-102-99, contains the characteristics set forth in Section 5709.61(A) of the Ohio Revised Code and certified said area Zone 354C as an Enterprise Zone under said Chapter 5709; and

WHEREAS, TOWNSHIP and COUNTY having the appropriate authority for the stated type of project are desirous of providing COMPANY with incentives available for the development of the PROJECT in said Enterprise Zone Chapter 5709 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, COMPANY has submitted a proposed agreement application ("APPLICATION" herein attached as Exhibit A) to TOWNSHIP and COUNTY said application (hereinafter referred to as "APPLICATION"); and

WHEREAS, COMPANY has remitted the required state application fee of \$750.00 made payable to the Ohio Development Services Agency with the application to be forwarded with the final agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise Zone Manager, Melanie Nealeigh, of Darke County has investigated the application of COMPANY and has recommended the same to the Township Board of Trustees of Greenville Township and the Board of Commissioners of Darke County on the basis that COMPANY is qualified by financial responsibility and business experience to create and preserve employment opportunities in said Enterprise Zone and improve the economic climate of TOWNSHIP and COUNTY; and

(SECTION 1 THRU 4 CAN BE SEEN IN FULL IN THE COMM.'S AND/OR ENTERPRISE ZONE FILES)

5. COMPANY must file the appropriate tax forms (DTE 24) with the County Auditor to effect and maintain the exemptions covered in the agreement.

6. COMPANY shall pay an annual fee equal to the greater of one percent of the dollar value of incentives offered under the agreement or five hundred dollars; provided, however, that if the value of the incentives exceeds two hundred fifty thousand dollars, the fee shall not exceed two thousand five hundred dollars.

The fee shall be made payable to Darke County once per year for each year the agreement is effective on the 15th day of January by certified check. The fee is to be paid to the Enterprise Zone Manager and made out to Darke County Treasurer. This fee shall be

deposited in a special fund created for such purpose and shall be used exclusively for the purpose of complying with Section 5709.68 of the Revised Code and by the tax incentive review council created under Section 5709.85 of the Revised Code exclusively for the purposes of performing the duties prescribed under that section.

(SECTION 7 THRU 16 CAN BE SEEN IN FULL IN THE COMM.'S AND/OR ENTERPRISE ZONE FILES)

17. This agreement is not transferable or assignable without the express, written approval of TOWNSHIP and COUNTY.
